

# Marion County Fair Kids Power Wheel

## Demo Rules

*Saturday, July 30, 2016*



Derby Begins @ 7pm

Weather Permitting

Entry Deadline: **July 22**

- A. This is supposed to be FUN for the kids. Parents please let them have fun! Judges can rule that children won't participate if there are modifications to the car more than those allowed that are outlined below!
- B. Any regular electric Power Wheel is allowed. NO 4-wheelers, motorcycles or tractor type vehicles allowed. Child's legs MUST be in the compartment. Must be a vehicle they **sit IN, not ON**.
- C. Kids 3-10 years of age may participate. There are 2 age groups: 3-5 and 6-10.
- D. **Helmets are mandatory.** Bicycle helmets are acceptable (full face style highly recommended).
- E. Must have a seatbelt AND use it!
- F. Shoes or sneakers required. NO sandals will be permitted.
- G. The vehicle is allowed to have **UP TO** 12 volt lawn mower battery, which cannot be mounted in the passenger seat. Battery must be secured and sealed away from the child.
- H. All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut. No sharp edges. Use zip ties or duct tape or other flexible product for making them stay shut.
- I. **Stock tires only.** No screws in tires, no chains. Stock tires may be covered in duct tape to prevent them from breaking.

- J. Motor must remain stock. The **ONLY** modification you may use and will be allowed is using a lawn mower battery.
- K. **Decorative Changes** can be made to the Power Wheel to make it look like a demo derby car, however, there can be **NO REINFORCEMENTS** to the power wheel. Changes and additions are only decorative--i.e., header pipes sticking up, painting the car, etc. Let your child decorate their own power wheel!
- L. All power wheels will be checked in at pit gate then impounded until time for the event.
- M. **NO PASSENGERS.**
- N. Everyone must pay gate admission to the derby (both adults/child).
- O. One parent will be allowed on the track with their child during the event.
- P. For safety off all participants: If a child gets out of the power wheel during the event, that child is out of the event.
- Q. If vehicle has more than one speed, **LOW SPEED** must be used.
- R. This will be a timed event. All cars will be outfitted with 4 balloons (supplied at the event) with one balloon being attached (by the derby committee) to each wheel or to each corner of said vehicle.
- S. The object is to be the last car running with balloon(s) intact, **OR** have the most balloons intact at the end of the timed event. If at the end of the timed limit, there is more than one contestant with the same number of balloons un-popped, it will be declared a tie.
- T. Every child must **pre-enter**, as all registered participants will receive a small award. Entrants will be accepted the day of the event, but pre-entry is strongly encouraged.
- U. **MANDATORY:** Parent/Guardian must have a signed waiver on file or sign a waiver the day of the event for children to participate.
- V. **NO ENTRY FEE.**

**Parents, at all times remember this is for FUN, this is for the kids.**
